Sub: Guidelines for the Generic Elective Courses (GECs) in M. Sc. - III and IV Semester.

The guidelines regarding the Generic Elective Courses (GECs) to be offered in the M. Sc. III – Semester, in the Departments of Applied Physics, Applied Mathematics and Biotechnology, are defined as under:

- A 4-credit GEC to be offered in the M. Sc. Semester III and IV shall be chosen by the students from basket of electives offered for B. Tech – Semester VII and VIII, respectively.
- 2. The DECs of M. Sc. Programmes shall be open for B. Tech VII and VIII Semester as GECs.
- 3. The Class size/strength for any section would be a minimum of 20 students and a maximum of 60 70 students. Further, the students from other departments can also register in these GECs offered by a particular department and there will be no minimum/maximum limit for students of other departments.

The above guidelines are being issued with the prior approval of the Competent Authority. θ
