Admission Criteria for B.A. (H) Economics (2023-24)

Prospective candidates interested in applying for the BA (H) Economics programme at the University School of Management & Entrepreneurship (USME), East Delhi Campus, Delhi Technological University should take note that admission to the programme for the 2023-24 academic session will be based on the scores obtained in the following combination of subjects in the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) being administered by the National Testing Agency (NTA):

Mathematics (Section II) + Any two other subjects from Section II + Any one language from Section IA or alternatively any one additional subject from Section II in lieu of a language from Section IA

- (i) Candidates are hereby advised to register on the CUET (UG) portal and opt for the above subject combination, in total four papers.
- (ii) A separate registration form to apply for DTU's BA (H) Economics programme will be released around the time of the declaration of CUET UG results on the University's official website <u>www.dtu.ac.in</u>. Candidates will be required to fill in their CUET scores obtained in the above-mentioned subject combination in the application form.

Eligibility Criteria for B.A.(H) Economics (2023-24)

- 1. The candidate must have appeared in the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) -UG 2023 being conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- 2. The candidate must have scored at least 50% marks in the 12th board examination from a recognised board and must also have passed Mathematics as a subject in the 12th Board Examination. Those who are appearing in the examination may also apply, provided that they submit the proof of eligibility by a specific date declared by the University.
- 3. Candidates belonging to various reserved categories namely OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, and sub-categories namely Defence, Person with Disability, who apply for seats reserved for them, shall be allowed a relaxation in the minimum marks criterion as mentioned below:

- Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL): Candidates claiming reservation under Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) category shall be allowed a relaxation of 5% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST): Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Caste (SC) or Scheduled Tribe (ST) shall be allowed a relaxation of 10% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- Defence Personnel: Candidates claiming reservation under Defence sub-category (CW) shall be allowed a relaxation of 5% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- Person with Disability (PwD): Candidates claiming reservation under "Person with Disability" (PD) sub-category shall be allowed a relaxation of 10% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
