invited for the First Round of Counselling**

The shortlisting of the registered applicants has been done on the basis of sum of normalised CUET –UG score derived from taking the **scores of Mathematics (Section II) + Any two other subjects from Section II + Any one language from Section IA or alternatively any one additional subject from Section II in lieu of a language from Section IA.**

Applicants fulfilling the below mentioned criteria are hereby informed to appear for the first round of counselling for admission to the BA (H) Economics programme for the session 2023-24:

**The following may be noted:**

- 1. Calling of the candidates for counselling shall not be considered as entitlement for admission. Greater number of candidates than seats available have been called to ensure that seats do not remain vacant. In case, a candidate is absent, the seat will be offered to the next candidate in the merit list.**
2. Candidates will not be allowed to mark their attendance one hour after the reporting time for each slot and late-comers will not be eligible for the first round of counselling.
3. The allotment of seats will be done according to the merit of the candidates who mark their attendance and as per the seat matrix given in the Admission Brochure.
4. Candidates who have been invited to participate in the first round of counselling, but fail to appear, will not be allowed to participate in the subsequent Counselling rounds. However, they may participate in the **spot round** (if any).
5. Candidates who cannot come physically can authorize their parent/relative/guardian/friends as their representative to participate in the counselling round on their behalf and complete admission formalities. No other relaxation will be given in the procedure of admission. Respective representatives will have to carry a valid ID proof and letter of undertaking from the candidate along with original & photocopy of required documents. Only the student or his/her one representative will be allowed inside the counselling venue to maintain social distancing norms.
6. Limited parking facility will be available at the venue. Candidates are advised to use public transport to reach the venue. The nearest stations of the Delhi Metro are Mansarovar Park on the Red Line and Karkardooma on the Blue/Pink Line.

### **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING**

The candidates must produce the following documents (**original as well as one-self attested photocopy**) in the order given below:

- (i) Demand draft of Rs 1,05,200 (Rupees One Lakh Five Thousand Two Hundred only) for the First Year Fee drawn in favour of “**Registrar DTU Admission East Delhi Campus**” payable at **Delhi**.
- (ii) Print-out of the online application form for DTU’s BA (H) Economics Programme
- (iii) Score Card of CUET (UG)
- (iv) Mark sheet of Class XII
- (v) Provisional certificate or Passing certificate from school duly stamped and signed by the principal
- (vi) Class X certificate/marksheet for date of birth proof
- (vii) Reserved category (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/KM/SG)/sub-category (Defence/PwD) Certificates, if applicable

**Noe: The formats of some of these certificates have been provided in the Admission Brochure. In case of OBC-NCL and EWS categories, the certificates should be issued after March 31, 2023. The candidate's names on the reserved category certificates and Class XII marksheets should be exactly the same, otherwise an affidavit to this end will have to be produced.**

- (viii) For candidates who have passed Class XII through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School Delhi (NIOS), the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of their centre of examination. Such candidates must bring a copy of their admit card.
