The NOTE at the end of each list, already uploaded, be read as follows:

- 1. The candidates with remarks mentioned against their names may submit their representations along with requisite documents/proof for their claim through the link (http://recruitment.dtu.ac.in/docver) available on University website within 10 days of the uploading of this list, failing which their claim for exemption/ weightage in screening test/ eligibility for screening test, as the case may be, shall not be considered.
- 2. No such request beyond the closing date shall be entertained.
- 3. The applications have been scrutinized as per the impact factors Journal Citation Report (JCR) 2019, available as on the closing date of online application submission. Very recently, JCR 2020 edition has been released. The University has decided to consider the higher of the two Impact Factors (JCR 2019 and JCR 2020). In light of the above, it will be the sole responsibility of the applicant to bring to the notice of the University any update/ any discrepancy with regard to exemption of candidates from screening test/ weightage of candidates in screening test by submitting representations at the link available at the University website.
- 4. All candidates eligible for 'exemption from screening test' and 'weightage in screening test' should submit the duly filled-in proforma regarding publication details available on University website, along with full text of publications, within 10 days of the uploading of this list. However, updating the impact factor as per JCR 2019/2020 will be the sole responsibility of the candidate concerned. Only after the verification of publications will they be eligible for exemption from screening test/ 'weightage in screening test', as the case may be.
