ELECTION FOR THE CLASS REPRESENTATIVES, PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, SECRETARY AND JOINT SECRETARY of STUDENT ASSOCIATION of DTU.

The President, Vice President, Secretary, and Joint Secretary (Office Bearers) of DTU Students Association (DTUSA) shall be elected by the Electoral College comprising of the **Class Representatives** elected by the **students** of each program of B.Tech/M.Tech/MBA semester wise as per announced schedule. **The Election of Class Representative for B.Tech/M.Tech/MBA shall be held on 28.08.2017 (Monday) between 10-11AM and Election of Office Bearers of DTUSA will be held on 31.08.2017 (Thursday) between 2-4PM**

Election Officials

Prof. Rangnath M. S. Department of Mechanical Engineering has been appointed as Chief Election Officer, Dr. Nand Kumar Assistant Professor, Dr Nitin Puri, Assistant Professor, have been appointed as Election Officers. Mr. Anil Kumar (DR, Academic, PG) will support the election officials to conduct a free and fair elections. Prof. Neeta Pandey will act as Observer for the entire Election Process. **The detailed scheduled for submission of nomination form etc. is displayed on the notice boards of the University and website.**

General Guidelines:

- The students who desire to contest election for the post of **Class Representative** and the **Elected Class Representatives** who desire to contest election for the post of **President, Vice President, Secretary and Joint Secretary** of Students Association, DTU shall obtain their **Nomination forms**, from the **Academic Section DTU** and submit the completed forms of **Class Representatives** in the **Academic branch** and the completed forms of **Office bearers DTUSA** in **Dean Student Welfare office** as per schedule notified.
- The students filing nominations for above posts will need to attach a photocopy of **Identity Card and Mark Sheets** of previous semesters along with nomination form.
- **New students**, who have not received ID card may submit copy of the registration along with fee receipt.
- Any student who was subjected to any disciplinary action/unfair means action by the university authorities or against whom any disciplinary/ unfair means proceedings are pending will not be eligible to contest election. Any student who has been tried and/or convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanor will also not be eligible to contest election.
- The upper age limit for eligibility to contest elections for B.Tech. Students is 23 years and for M.Tech/MBA students is 25 years.
- The candidates can have a maximum of two opportunities to contest for election of class Representative and one opportunity to contest for the elections of office Bearer.
- **The last date for submission of nomination form for Class Representative is 24th August, 2017 (Thursday) 4.00 p.m. and for Office bearers of DTUSA is 29th August, 2017 (Tuesday), 4PM.**

- All the students of B.Tech/M.Tech/MBA are, therefore, advised to get their identity cards revalidated/issued a fresh from Academic Section well in advance. All the newly admitted students of B.Tech (I Semester) and M.Tech/MBA(1 Semester) are advised to get their Identity cards issued from the Academic Section (Admin Block).
- The students submitting nomination for the post of President, Vice President, Secretary and Joint Secretary DTU SA shall be required to submit a demand draft/Pay Order of Rs.500/- in favour of **Registrar, DTU** along with their nomination form and Nomination Papers. In case, any candidate fails to deposit the demand draft his/her candidature for the said post shall be deemed to have been withdrawn by the said candidate. The security deposit shall be forfeited, in case a candidate fails to get at least 10% of the total votes cast for the post for which he/she is seeking election.
