For first year courses, Mr. Piyush Vaish, Knowledge Network Manager and the respective course coordinators after consolidating the attendance shortage records of all the groups (A/1 to A15, B/1 to B/15) in a particular course will submit the list of students whose attendance is less than 75% to the respective HoDs in the format enclosed ATT. 2/7 of B.Tech. Ordinance for forwarding to the academic section. Academic (UG) section will consolidate the details of medical leave of 1st year students and send to respective course coordinators.

The HoDs are requested to provide logistical support to time table incharges / Coordinator Attendance monitoring for the consolidation. As the students have been asked to submit the medical certificate to the HoD of the concern course/department, the HoDs are requested to consider the medical certificates and allow a relaxation upto 10% on medical/other bonafide duties. The list of students detained in a particular course shall be displayed on the notice board and communicated to Associate Dean Academic (UG) for further necessary action.
