5. Contractor shall submit neatly prepare electrical inventory of fittings provided along with completion plan in triplicate (one of them on tracing cloth) and also test report of the electrical installation failing which necessary recovery will be affected.
6. If any condition's is put by the contractor, which is not as per CPWD specifications/terms and conditions of NIT, his tender is liable to be rejected.
7. Contractor will have to abide by the instructions contained in CPWD work Manual (upto date) applicable to him.
8. Dismantalled material/malwa generated during execution of the work shall be removed from the site daily and site kept neat and clean failing which suitable recovery will be made from the contractors bill.
9. The building is fully occupied and functional. During office hours Staff and public movements are in the premises. So it will not be allowed to carry out work during office hours. So firm has to carry out scrupulously and judiciously utilized their manpower and materials beyond office hour ie specially night hours. The firm has to complete this entire work within the stipulated period
