<u>VENUE FOR THE FIRST ROUND OF COUNSELLING</u>: Auditorium, East Delhi Campus, Delhi Technological University, Vivek Vihar Phase II, Delhi 110095

The shortlisting of the registered applicants has been done on the basis of **sum of scores in CUET –UG 2024 in the following subjects**:

- 1. Mathematics (Section II)
- 2. Any two other subjects from Section II
- 3. Any one language from Section IA or alternatively any one additional subject from Section II in lieu of a language from Section IA.

Please note the following:

<u>**DELHI REGION:**</u> The students who have qualified the Class XII exam from the schools located in Delhi (having the PIN CODE of Delhi), irrespective of their domicile, would be considered as "Delhi Region Candidates".

<u>OUTSIDE DELHI REGION:</u> The students who have qualified the Class XII exam from the schools located outside Delhi would be considered as "Outside Delhi Region Candidates".

- For candidates who have qualified Class XII through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School Delhi (NIOS) or any other mode of correspondence, the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of their centre of examination. Such candidates must bring a copy of their Class XII admit cards.

The following may be noted:

- 1. Participation in counselling does not entitle candidates to admission. A greater number of candidates than available seats have been invited to ensure no seats remain vacant. If a candidate is absent, the seat will be offered to the next candidate in the merit list.
- 2. Candidates must mark their attendance within the reporting time. Latecomers will not be eligible for the first round of counselling.
- 3. Seat allotment will be based on the merit of candidates who mark their attendance and according to the seat matrix provided in the Admission Brochure.
- 4. Candidates invited for the first round of counselling who fail to appear will not be allowed to participate in subsequent rounds. However, they may participate in the spot round.
- 5. Candidates unable to attend physically can authorize a representative to participate in the counselling round and complete admission formalities. Representatives must carry a valid ID proof, a letter of authorization from the candidate, and original & photocopies of required documents.
- 6. Only the student and his/her one representative will be allowed inside the counselling venue.
- 7. Limited parking facilities will be available at the venue. Candidates are advised to consider alternative transportation options. The nearest Delhi Metro stations are Mansarovar Park on the Red Line and Karkardooma on the Blue/Pink Line.
- 8. Candidates are advised to regularly visit the website www.dtu.ac.in for updates on the admission process.

- (i) Demand draft of Rs 1,10,200 (Rupees One Lakh Ten Thousand Two Hundred only) for the First Year Fee drawn in favour of "Registrar DTU Admission East Delhi Campus" payable at Delhi. (NO OTHER MODE OF PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED)
- (ii) Print-out of the online application form for DTU's BA (H) Economics Programme
- (iii) Score Card of CUET (UG) 2024
- (iv) Mark sheet of Class XII
- (v) Provisional certificate or Passing certificate from the school, duly stamped and signed by the principal
- (vi) Class X certificate/marksheet for date of birth proof
- (vii) Reserved category (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/KM/SG)/sub-category (Defence/PwD) Certificates, if applicable
 - **Note:** (a) The formats of some of these certificates have been provided in the Admission Brochure.
 - (b) For OBC-NCL and EWS categories, only certificates issued after March 31, 2024, will be valid for admission purpose. Candidates with certificates issued before March 31, 2024, will not be eligible to participate in these categories. Production of only acknowledgments indicating that new certificates are in process will not be accepted.
- (viii) The candidate's names on the reserved category certificates and Class XII marksheet should be exactly the same, otherwise an affidavit to this end will have to be produced.
- (ix) For candidates who have passed Class XII through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School Delhi (NIOS) or any other mode of correspondence, the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of their centre of examination. Such candidates must bring a copy of their admit card.
- (x) Medical fitness certificate
