

2nd Lecture of the Distinguished Lecture Series

The Department of Environmental Engineering organized the second lecture of its Distinguished Lecture Series on 18 February 2026 at 2:00 PM in the departmental seminar hall. The session was conducted under the theme “*Balance Brings Brilliance*” and aimed at guiding students on effective preparation strategies and overall personal development.

The keynote address was delivered by Mr. Dushyant Singh, who secured All India Rank 45 in the Engineering Services Examination (ESE) 2025. In his talk, he emphasized the importance of maintaining a healthy balance between academics, sports, co-curricular activities, and personal life, including time for family and friends. He highlighted that a well-balanced routine not only improves productivity but also enhances mental well-being and long-term performance. Mr. Singh also shared insights into his preparation journey and explained how his academic background in Environmental Engineering played a significant role during the ESE interview stage.

The lecture was attended by around 50 participants, including students from B.Tech, M.Tech, and Ph.D. programs, along with faculty members of the department. An interactive session followed the talk, during which students sought guidance on effective preparation methodologies, managing ESE preparation alongside regular coursework, and understanding the eligibility of Environmental Engineering students for the ESE examination.

The session proved to be informative and motivating, providing students with practical strategies for exam preparation while reinforcing the importance of maintaining balance for achieving academic and professional excellence.
