National Pollution Control Day

The Department of Environmental Science and Engineering, Delhi Technological University, in association with the Institution's Innovation Council, organized a talk to observe "National Pollution Control Day" on 24th February 2026. The event aimed to raise awareness about environmental protection, pollution mitigation strategies, and sustainable management practices in alignment with national environmental priorities.

Mr. G. Rambabu, Scientist-E at the Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi was the invited speaker. During his talk, Mr. Rambabu discussed about Emerging challenges in hazardous waste management; scientific approaches to remediation of contaminated sites; importance of legal enforcement in environmental governance; and the role of circular economy in sustainable industrial growth.

The seminar concluded with an engaging interactive session, where students, research scholars and faculty members discussed regulatory mechanisms, site remediation technologies, and evolving environmental policies. The event served as an enriching platform to gain insights into real-world environmental governance and the functioning of national regulatory bodies.
