INTRODUCTION

Physical Education and Sports play vital role in achieving the aims and objectives of Education. The students of DTU are provided with excellent facilities and encouraged to take part in the sports tournaments held in Delhi and professional institutions, of N.C.R.

DTU has 400 m. Running Track, ground for Football, Hockey, Cricket, two courts for Volleyball, two courts of Basketball, three courts of Lawn Tennis, five courts for Badminton, Kabaddi Court, Table Tennis, Chess, Carrom, Pool Table and Gyms are also available in the university campus.

With a view to recognizing upcoming talented sportsmen and sportswomen in the university, the Sports Council of DTU organizes many sports tournaments in the Campus. Large Number participation of boys and girls participate in the sports event that which include Athletics, Badminton, Table Tennis, Basketball, Carrom, Chess, Cricket, Tennis, Pool, Kabaddi and Volleyball. Cash Prizes and certificates are awarded to the winners.

Foundation Elective Course (FEC) - Sports course first time started in the university in the academic session 2018-19 for the students of DTU with two credits for each semester. 








