



NOTICE FOR SELECTION OF USIP INTERNS

Delhi Technological University has launched University Student Internship Program (USIP) to engage DTU students in various activities of the university in December 2016. The impetus of the program is to provide opportunity to expose students to real life environment and to help university in improving processes and activities undertaken time to time by deploying students in (i) main USIP for assisting in various departments/offices (ii) DTU- Incubation and Innovation Foundation (IIF) startups to assist various startups and (iii) Outreach Extension and Activities- Lab on Wheels (OEA-LOW) to teach students of Govt. schools of Delhi.

Therefore, only really interested students of DTU main campus may apply in only one of the followings (multiple applications from same student will get rejected):

1. Under Main USIP, the interns have to contribute towards various portfolios like report and documentation preparation, data analysis, coordination and networking, preparation of speech and creative writing, website preparation management, operations and monitoring of gadgets/appliances; admissions and counselling, event management, etc.
2. Under DTU-IIF Startups, the interns have to assist startups in DTU-IIF through their technical skills and knowledge.
3. Under OEA-LOW to teach Basic Computer Course (BCC) and Basic Python Programming (BPP) to students of Govt. schools of Delhi as per schedule provided by OEA office.



The student interns are required to work for minimum eight hours a week including weekends and holidays, and will be paid Rs. 3500/- per month on successful completion.

It is now planned to select interns for next round tentatively in second or third week of August, 2024.


Note: The interns are expected to work in OFFLINE mode ONLY, so only those who are really interested and can report to DTU campus, need to apply. Who have applied/deployed/selected earlier in USIP need to apply afresh.

The last date for submitting the form is 05/08/2024, Monday, 05:00 PM. Shortlisted applicants will be informed through DTU website. The applicants are required to see the university website regularly for further updates.
