Introduction:-

Event Description:-

The first round will be a group discussion and the students who qualify this round will go to the final round.

ROUND - 1 Group Discussion

Rules for Group Discussion-

1. Participants will be divided into groups.
2. Each group will be provided a particular topic on the spot.
3. 30 seconds will be given to the group to think about the topic given.
4. Post the 30 second prep time, the discussion will start and 3 minutes time will be provided to discuss over the topic.
5. The jury will select the top members from each group and they will qualify for the final round of JAM.
6. The decision of the jury will be final and binding.

ROUND - 2 Just A Minute

Rules for JAM:-

1. A visual clip would be shown to the contestants one at a time.
2. Thirty seconds would be provided to view the clip and plan accordingly in order to present your ideas in an effective and interesting manner.
3. The contestant is then given one minute by the moderator to speak on the topic. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
4. In case of any dispute, the decision of the judges would be final and binding.

5. The organizers reserve the right to change and modify the rules and regulations without any prior notification.
